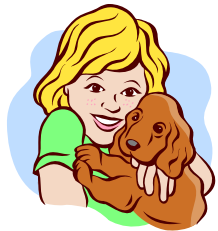
Add on- Mrs Mc Odd had a son when they changed plain and they named him Luke.
